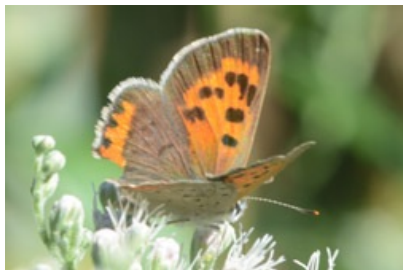
Saturday, June 25, 2022 9:00 am FIELD TRIP
